

CITY OF DIAMOND CITY, ARKANSAS RESOLUTION NO. 04-2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A CITY ATTORNEY AND ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-42-112, cities of the second class may elect or appoint a municipal attorney as provided by ordinance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-43-313 and § 14-43-314, municipalities are authorized to prescribe by ordinance the duties and compensation of municipal officers, including the city attorney;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-55-101, municipalities possess authority to enact measures necessary for the good governance of the city;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and in the best interest of the City to employ legal counsel to represent the City in all legal matters, including municipal court proceedings, civil litigation, ordinance drafting, contract review, and general legal advice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DIAMOND CITY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Employment Authorized.

The City Council hereby authorizes the employment of Kendra Robinson, Attorney at Law, to serve as City Attorney for the City of Diamond City, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. Scope of Duties.

The City Attorney shall:

1. Represent the City in municipal court proceedings and other courts of competent jurisdiction.
2. Provide legal advice to the Mayor, City Council, and City officials.
3. Draft and review ordinances, resolutions, contracts, and other legal documents;
4. Attend regular and special City Council meetings as requested;
5. Perform such additional legal job services as may be authorized by the City Council.

SECTION 3. Compensation.

Compensation for services shall be determined by separate written engagement agreement approved by the City Council. The Mayor is authorized to execute such agreement consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. Term.

The appointment shall continue at the pleasure of the City Council unless otherwise specified in the written engagement agreement.

SECTION 5. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is declared invalid, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

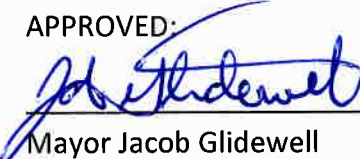
SECTION 6. Effective Date.

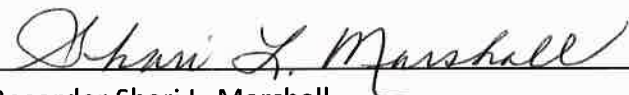
