ORDINANCE NUMBER 13-11

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 12-11 BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DIAMOND CITY, BOONE COUNTY, ARKANSAS TO AMEND THE DATE OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION FOR A 1% SALES TAX INCREASE FOR POLICE PROTECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Diamond City finds it prudent to hold its Special Election in conjunction with the Cities of Lead Hill and Harrison, and the County of Boone; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the changes made in the law during the 2011 Legislative session, and

WHEREAS, those government entities have determined to hold their special elections on November 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, holding the election in conjunction with the these government entities is more cost effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF DIAMOND CITY DOES HEREBY AMEND ORDINANCE 12-11 AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Diamond City hereby amends the election date set in Ordinance 12-11 as October 11, 2011, to November 8, 2011.

All other provisions of Ordinance 12-11 remain in full force and effective.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The City Council hereby determines that this Ordinance is necessary to meet the time constraints required by law passed during the 2011 Legislative Session for holding a Special Election. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being immediately necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens, shall become effective on the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor.
